Sharing Christ with Your Testimony


- **Underline** what Jesus told the man to do.

We may not know much about the Bible or Theology, but we are experts on our lives.

- People are more interested in what God has done for us, than what we've done for God.
- Our **TESTIMONY** is the story of what *Christ has done in our lives*!

How to Share Your Testimony

- **1. Your Life Before Christ:** Share **briefly** about your life before you were saved.
 - ${\bf \circ}$ Don't spend too much time sharing details of how bad you were.
 - O If you were saved at a young age, you may not remember much of your early life.
- **2. How You Came to Know Christ:** Share **how** you heard about Christ, and **how** you decided to trust Him for forgiveness.
 - O That enables the person to hear a clear presentation of how to become a Christian.
- 3. Your Life After Receiving Christ: Share how Christ changed your life!

The Great Commission

We are HERE instead of in HEAVEN to fulfill Jesus' final command to all Christians.

Christ's final instructions to His disciples are often called *The Great Commission*, because Jesus commissions them to take the Gospel to the world.

"Then Jesus came to them and said,

'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations,

baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20, NIV

- Frame where we are to "go and make disciples."
 - ♦ You can't reach people for Christ unless you *go* to them.
- **Underline** in whose name Christians are baptized.
 - ♦ Baptism is a public way to identify that you became a Christian. This act of obedience symbolizes you are cleansed from sin by Jesus's death, burial, and resurrection.
- **&** Circle what we are to teach new disciples.
 - ♦ Making a disciple is more than just explaining the Gospel to someone. It involves teaching a person about God and His Word so the person grows in faith and is prepared to share the Good News with others.



The Great Commission is for ALL Christians, not just pastors and missionaries.

"But in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect." 1 Peter 3:15, ESV



- ❖ Underline what we should always be "prepared" to do.
- **Circle** *two* attitudes we should have when we witness.

"However, I [Paul] consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me, the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace." Acts 20:24, NIV



- Underline Paul's "only aim."
- ❖ Circle the "task" the Lord Jesus had given him.

Paul devoted his life to sharing the Good News of Salvation with others.

Underline the description of a "wise" person.

The Plan

Where do you start when you are trying to "make disciples of all nations"? Acts 1:8 gives us The Plan to follow.

.....

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and

in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8, ESV



❖ Underline all the geographic areas where we are to be Christ's "witnesses."

<u>JERUSALEM</u> represented the home area of Jesus' disciples.

It would be your home town/city, family, and friends.

<u>JUDEA & SAMARIA</u> were 2 provinces. Judea's capital was Jerusalem. It would be your state, province, or country.

END OF THE EARTH is **everyone** who needs to be reached with the Gospel. *It includes all nations of the world.*



We can witness to people in our Jerusalem, and also work with other Christians to reach everyone in our Judea & Samaria. Reaching the ends of the earth may involve Christians going to live in other nations.

 Every Christian should be willing to go. But even if we do not go, we should support missionaries with our prayers and finances!

Spiritual Multiplication


"And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men
